CLERK: 13 ayes, 20 nays on the motion to bracket the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion fails. Back to the amendment. Any discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Ashford? Seeing none, those in favor of the adoption of the amendment please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Select File amendment as offered by Senator Ashford.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: I just move to advance the bill to E & R Engrossment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion? A machine vote has been requested. All in favor of the motion to advance the bill to E & R Engrossing please vote aye, opposed nay. On the motion to advance or readvance, have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to readvance the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion adopted. Next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill up for consideration is LB 784. The first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Abboud. (Abboud amendment appears on page 2610 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. President, colleagues, I have an amendment up that provides for striking out of the budget \$185,942. It deals with the legislative computers. Now, we're at a point at this time in the session of having to make some decisions. Today we decided that we weren't going to have a sales tax increase and an income tax increase. I think it is important time in the session that we have to establish certain priorities. Now when I first placed these amendments up on LB 784 it was not my intention to be debating these particular amendments at eight-thirty, eight twenty-two in the evening.
