ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 2652-53 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 7 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 603 passes. LB 603A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 603A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 603A pass? LB 603A passes. Was a late night, wasn't it. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
