LB 182, 279, 390, 390A, 408, 416

CLERK: (Read LB 416 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: Having complied with all the provisions of law relative to procedure, the question is, shall LB 416 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2674 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 416 passes with the emergency clause attached. May I introduce some guests, please. In the north balcony Senator Higgins has 50 fourth graders from the Field Club in Omaha and their teachers. Would you students and teachers please stand to be recognized. Thank you for visiting us today. Mr. Speaker, would you give us some words of wisdom here?
