LB 191, 257, 428, 675, 757, 825, 1010-1026

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 217 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

PRESIDENT: LB 757 is indefinitely postponed. Anything to put in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do.

PRESIDENT: The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read for the first time by title: LBs 1010-1026. See pages 217-21 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, notice of hearing from the Education Committee, that is offered by Senator Withem. Committee on Enrollment and Review who have carefully examined and reviewed LB 428 recommend the same be placed on Select File with E & R amendments attached. (See page 222 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have a motion to withdraw LB 825, offered by Senator Elmer. That will be laid over.

Mr. President, a communique from Senator Labeledz as Chair of the Executive Board announcing that Senator Campbell has been selected to serve on the Building Maintenance Committee. And the last item, Mr. President, Senator Bernard-Stevens would like to add his name to 191 as co-introducer. That is all that I have.

PRESIDENT: We will move on to LB 675. Senator Chambers, do you want to work on your 675 today? Pardon me. Oh, all right, do you want to take up the motion first? All right. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, excuse me, Senator, the bill is offered by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) Considered last year, Mr. President. Senator Chambers is correct, Senator Schmit has a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator, your prerogative is to lay it over at this time?

PRESIDENT: You do want to lay it over? All right. LB 675 will be laid over. We will move on then to LB 275, Senator Wesely's bill. Let's say 257, shall we? Mr. Clerk.
