But with the opinion some people have of me, that couldn't surprise you if I did it. If I was a pedophile, it couldn't surprise you. If I was a rapist, it couldn't surprise you. But for some of you all who are so pristine pure, if we determined certain things about you all, then we might be shocked, because how is it that people who have lived life and understand life can be so willing to try to tell others what they cannot experience? This bill is not talking about child pornography. It is talking about a much broader range and it's dealing with people other than juveniles or minors or whatever image you have in your mind of the category of persons we're talking about. It deals with people as ancient as some of us here, as ancient as some of us here. Maybe I want to see whether somebody's hair is real so I get one of those cards that were circulated in elementary school or high school and are probably being circulated now and show it to them to see if their eyebrows jump off their forehead and that hair jumps off the top of their head.
