SPEAKER BARRETT: A call of the house has been requested, call in votes are authorized. Those in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 1 nay to go under call.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The house is under call. Please return to your seats, record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber. Call in votes on the adoption of the Hall amendment are authorized.

CLERK: Senator Hannibal voting yes. Senator Goodrich voting yes. Senator Peterson voting no. Senator Conway voting yes. Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Smith voting yes.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Hall amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The Hall amendment is adopted. Anything further?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The call is raised. Senator Hall, to the bill.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move LB 377 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER BARRETT: You've heard the motion to advance the bill. Any discussion? Seeing none, all in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the advancement of the bill? Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 377.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 377 is advanced. Anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1089 and
