CLERK: Mr. President, the other item I have this morning are amendments from Senator Hall to LB 557 to be printed in the Journal. (See page 379 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have.

PRESIDENT: Okay, how about new bills? The Clerk would like to number some of the new bills so we will go on to Select File, Senator Moore, and work some of the Select File for a while.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill up for consideration is LB 180. The first item I have, Senator, are Enrollment and Review amendments.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. President, I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 180.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Smith would move to amend the bill. (Senators Smith's amendment is found on page 379 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Did you say Smith or Schmit?

CLERK: Smith.

PRESIDENT: Okay, Senator Smith, please.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I just have a simple amendment that would revise the Rogers amendment which is found on page 233 of the Journal and adopted January 11, 1988, which would strike "five hundred" and insert "one hundred". I have heard from...specifically, I will just be real direct with you, and I have heard from a company in my district who says, I conduct my business legitimately, I pay the cost of the device and I do all the things I am supposed to do. Why should I be penalized because there are some people in the state that are misusing the service? And so, for this reason, I introduce the amendment and would ask for its adoption.
