

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Okay, excuse me. I guess we are back on General File, can't do that anymore. Sorry. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Have a call of the house, please?

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the house be under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. There is only one excused. Senator Elmer, Senator Goodrich, Senator Hall, Senator Chambers, Senator Johanns, Senator Landis, Senator Langford, Senator Lynch, Senator McFarland, Senator Moore, Senator Nelson, Senator Pirsch, Senator Remmers. Is Senator Vard Johnson the only one excused? Senator Haberman, do you want call ins or roll call? Call ins are acceptable.

CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting yes. Senator Baack voting yes. Senator Weihsing voting yes. Senator Remmers voting yes. Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Landis voting no. PRESIDENT: Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of the bill.
