welcome Mr. Collingsworth today. Thank you for visiting us today. Mr. Clerk, do you have some things to put in?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, and I appreciate the opportunity. Thank you. Your Committee on Revenue, whose Chair is Senator Johnson, reports 836, 845, and 1044 to General File. Those are signed by Senator Johnson as Chair. I have a reference report referring LBs 1146 through 1178, signed by Senator Labeledz as Chair.

Mr. President, I have a new resolution offered by Senator Labeledz and a number of the members regarding the Nebraska Medical Center. (Read brief synopsis of LR 266. See pages 418-19 of the Journal.)

In conjunction with that, Mr. President, I have a letter from the Speaker referring that resolution to the Reference Committee for referral to a Standing Committee for public hearing.

Mr. President, Senator Abboud would like to print amendments to 352. I have a motion from Senator Vard Johnson to withdraw LB 843, that will be laid over pursuant to rule. (See page 419 of the Journal.)

Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1179-1205 by title for the first time. See pages 419-25 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. I understand we have a motion on the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb would move to indefinitely postpone LB 128. Senator Miller would have the option of laying the bill over if he so chose.
