PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Mike not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We're happy to have with us this morning Senator Miller's minister from Davenport, Nebraska, Reverend Don Hunziger and his wife, Laurie. Would you please rise for the invocation of the morning.

REVEREND HUNZIGER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Reverend Hunziger, we appreciate your being here, and Laurie, welcome back to favor us again with your prayer of the morning. We appreciate your coming on this cold day to, so far, to be with us. We appreciate it. Roll call, please. Record, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do we have any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Natural Resources, whose Chairman is Senator Schmit, to whom was referred LB 953, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File. In addition to that, Mr. President, I have a confirmation report from the Natural Resources Committee. I have a report from the Middle Niobrara NRD regarding payment of attorney fees to be on file in my office. Notice of hearing from the Appropriations Committee signed by Senator Warner. I have a gubernatorial appointment appointing Dr. Joe L. Williams to the State Board of Health.

And, Mr. President, LR 267 is now ready for your signature.
