LB 123, 672, 821

Mr. President, your Committee on Judiciary, whose Chair is Senator Chizek, reports LB 672 and LB 821 to General File, both signed by Senator Chizek. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are we ready to go to Final Reading, Mr. Clerk?

PRESIDENT: Senator Ashford. Senator Ashford, we are ready to take up your motion on the bill to return.

SENATOR ASHFORD: (Microphone not activated.) ...both amendments.

PRESIDENT: Okay, both amendments, did you say?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Both.

PRESIDENT: All right, they are both withdrawn. Do you have anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Okay, we'll begin Final Reading on LB 123.

CLERK: (Read LB 123 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 123 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have
