CLERK: (Read LB 428 on Final Reading.)

Senator Lynch. A roll call vote has been asked for. Check in. Okay, there are five excused. We will have a check in. Would you clear the board, please. Okay, please check in. Incidentally, gallery, you can't do that. Please withhold your applause. Senator Haberman, Senator Moore, Senator Korshoj. We are waiting for Senator Haberman. Roll call vote has been requested. Are you all in your seats? Mr. Clerk. Senator Conway requests reverse order. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read. See page 512 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill fails to pass. Anything to put in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, thank you. I have notice of hearings from Health and Human Services, provided by Senator Wesely as Chair.
