LB 419A, 419, 466, 758, 840, 884, 1051

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Any discussion? Seeing none, anything further, Senator Withem?

SENATOR WITHEM: I would urge the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the amendment. All in favor say aye...vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Withem, on the bill.

SENATOR WITHEM: I would move the advancement of the A bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, sir. Any discussion? If not, those in favor of the advancement of the A bill, please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 419A.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The bill is advanced. For the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Transportation Committee offers confirmation report. Transportation would offer LB 840 to General File; LB 884 to General File; LB 1051 to General File. Those are signed by Senator Lamb as Chair.

I have a request from Senators Smith and Campbell to add their names to LB 419.

Senator Vard Johnson would have amendments to LB 466 to be printed. (See pages 535-36 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 758 was a bill introduced by Senator Lamb. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 23, referred to the Banking Committee, advanced to General File and I have committee amendments pending by the Banking Committee.
