CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 545 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is not adopted. Do you have anything further on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Conway...

PRESIDENT: The call is raised.

CLERK: Senator Conway would move to indefinitely postpone the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall, what do you say about that?

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, let's lay it over.

PRESIDENT: Lay it over, all right. It is done. Mr. Clerk, do you have something to put into the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a new bill, LB 1232 introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read for the first time by title. See page 547-48 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have notice of hearing from the Agriculture Committee, signed by Senator Rod Johnson as Chair. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 370, LB 435, LB 445, LB 670, LB 673, LB 673A, LB 674, LB 676 all correctly Engrossed. (See page 548 of the Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue, whose Chair is Senator Vard Johnson, would report LB 834 to General File, LB 842, LB 1064, LB 832 all to General File, and LR 5CA, LR 20CA, LB 86, LB 210, LB 420, LB 734, and LB 925 all indefinitely postponed, all of those reports signed by Senator Johnson as Chair.
