CLERK: Yes, sir, there is. Mr. President, I have a series of reports. Revenue Committee, LB 1095, LB 1094, LB 1053, LB 959 are reported indefinitely postponed. LB 819 is reported to General File with amendments attached, LB 1105 General File with amendments attached, LB 1115 General File with amendments attached, all signed by Senator Vard Johnson as Chair. (See pages 586-87 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Business and Labor Committee, whose Chair is Senator Hall, reports LB 863 to General File, LB 892 to General File, LB 1033 to General File, LB 864 General File with amendments and LB 1035 as indefinitely postponed. (See pages 587-88 of the Legislative Journal.) All of those signed by Senator Hall as Chair of the Business and Labor Committee, Mr. President.

In addition to that, Mr. President, I have a report of registered lobbyists for this past week. And I have notice of hearing from the Business and Labor Committee signed by Senator Hall.

Mr. President, there will be an Urban Affairs Executive Session at eleven o'clock in the Senate Lounge, Urban Affairs Committee Exec Session eleven o'clock in the Senate Lounge. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. We'll go on to number eight, LB 90, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 90 was a bill introduced by Senators Scofield and others. (Title read.) The bill was introduced in January of last year, referred to the Judiciary Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File with amendments attached. The bill was last considered, Mr. President, on January 25. At that time Senator Hall made a motion to bracket the bill until January 28. Mr. President, I now have pending, Senator, may I assume that the amendments that we had prepared the other day are to be withdrawn?

PRESIDENT: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hall would move to amend the committee amendments. Senator Hall, this is AM1783. It is the first of your two, Senator, 1783.
