LB 602 as co-introducer, and I have a resolution ready for your signature, Mr. President. That is all that I have.

Those members not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber in anticipation of Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 697 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 697 pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 599-600 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 697 passes. LB 713E.

CLERK: (Read LB 713 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 713 with the emergency clause attached become law? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 600 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 713E passes. We will pass over LB 790 for the moment and move to LB 249, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 249 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 249 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.
