PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not activated.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning our own Reverend Harland Johnson of Lincoln who will be our chaplain of the day. Would you please rise.
