**PRESIDENT:** The motion fails. Do you have anything to put into the record, Mr. Clerk?

**CLERK:** Mr. President, I do. Your Committee on Retirement Systems reports LB 1169 to General File, LB 1170 General File, LB 160 General File with amendments, LB 965 indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Haberman as Chair. Education Committee reports LB 165 to General File, LB 904, LB 1077 to General File, LB 841 General File with amendments, LB 916 General File with amendments, LB 970 General File with amendments, LB 1073 General File with amendments and LB 1081, LB 1131 indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Withem. (See pages 655-61 of the Legislative Journal.)

New A bills, Mr. President. (Read LB 1100A, LB 1013A, LB 1008A by title for the first time as found on pages 661-62 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Schmit would like to print amendments to LB 953 and Senator Chizek to LB 352. (See pages 662-63 of the Legislative Journal. And that is all that I have.

**PRESIDENT:** We'll move on to LB 402.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, 402 is a bill that was introduced by Senators Schmit, Wehrbein and Remmers. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 20 of last year. At that time it was referred to the Education Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I have Education Committee amendments pending.

**PRESIDENT:** Senator Withem, do you wish to take up the amendments first?

**SENATOR WITHEM:** Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, LB 402 is a bill that was brought to us by Senator Schmit and Senator Remmers and Senator Wehrbein; deals with drug education, education in the classroom dealing with drugs. The committee, in advancing the bill, added the term, "controlled substance analogs" to the list of those items about which instruction in use of drugs, nonuse of drugs, problems with drugs, should be included.
