That is the hardest thing in the world to do. Senator Abboud, you can't easily get out from under what you're going to be under, you running for Congress, if you vote for this bill. You are mandating new requirements on the local school people and if you do it, I'm going to find a way to tell your constituents and I'm going to tell them that you were very inconsistent because you voted against that other bill and the rationale you gave for voting against that one should justify you in voting against this one.

PRESIDENT: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And if you don't believe your own arguments, why should anybody else?

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I'll ask for a call of the house and I'll accept call ins.

PRESIDENT: Okay. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. We're voting on the adoption of the Chambers amendment and he is accepting call in votes. Several of you have not recorded your presence. Would you please do that.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting yes. Senator Peterson voting no. Senator Vard Johnson voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.
