**PRESIDENT:** (Microphone not activated.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us as our Chaplain of the day, Reverend Maurice Goldhammer, who is the Pastor of the Calvary Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Nebraska. Would you please rise for the invocation.

Mr. President, priority bill designations by the Business and Labor Committee, LB 864 and LB 868. Signed by Senator Hall as Chair of that committee.
