**SPEAKER BARRETT:** LB 117 passes. LB 191E.

**CLERK:** (Read LB 191 on Final Reading.)

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 191 with the emergency clause attached become law? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

**CLERK:** (Read record vote as found on page 724 of the Legislative Journal.) 8 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on passage of the bill with the emergency clause attached.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** LB 191E fails to pass. The Chair now poses the question, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause stricken? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

**CLERK:** (Read record vote as found on page 725 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** LB 191 passes without the emergency clause. LB 790, Mr. Clerk.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** (Read LB 790 on Final Reading.)

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 790 become law? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** (Read record vote as found on page 726 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 10 excused and not voting Mr. President.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** LB 790 passes. Anything for the record?

**CLERK:** No, sir.
