PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the advancement of the A bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of 854A, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 854A is advanced. LB 962, please. Is anyone prepared to handle this, Senator Baack?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 962 by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7, referred to Government Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Baack, please.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. President and members, this was a bill that I agreed to handle for Senator Warner because he couldn't be here this morning. All this bill does is it would allow the Governor of the State of Nebraska to appoint members to the Capitol Environs Commission, and what that commission is it has been set up by the City of Lincoln and by Lancaster County, and this would just allow us to have some input on that committee, and they would deal with the area that surrounds the Capitol. Up to this point, we haven't had anybody on there. This way they would be able to have somebody on there. The Governor would appoint someone to be on that committee.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Any further discussion? If not, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. A little help there, please. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on advancement of LB 962, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 962 is advanced. LB 993.

CLERK: LB 993 offered by the Banking Committee. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7 of this year, referred to the Banking Committee for public hearing, Mr. President, was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
