PRESIDENT: Senator Beyer, please.

SENATOR BEYER: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, this is my annual resolution on behalf of the volunteers of the Extension Service, 4-H leaders and everything. It's one program that is very beneficial to the state and does not cost us any money with all the volunteer hours that are put in by these people. So with that, I would ask that you adopt the resolution. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. All those in favor of the resolution vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator McFarland, did you wish to speak on this? Okay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.
