SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President and members of the body, I think that we're honoring a gentleman here of unusual circumstances. So I would simply ask that the Legislature, if they would have a moment of silence in honor of Major Mike Bosiljevac. So if I could do that, if I could make that request, just a moment of silence in his behalf...on behalf of him and his family.

PRESIDENT: You may. Would you please rise for a moment of silence. (Gavel.)

SENATOR HARTNETT: Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you for bringing this to us on behalf of the family of Major Bosiljevac. We appreciate you gentlemen doing this. Now, will you please vote on the resolution. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. May I introduce some guests of Senator Conway, please. Under the north balcony we have Michael McCabe and Philip Schutte from the Midwestern Office of the Council of State Government. Would you gentlemen please stand and be recognized. Thank you for visiting us today. Mr. Clerk, something to put in the record, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hartnett would like to add his name to LR 278 as co-introducer. That is all that I have.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. We'll move on to Select File. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 375 is a bill that is on Select File. The bill, of course, was placed there last year. Mr. President, on April 30 of last year there was a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill that was offered by Senator Hall. Subsequent to that action, Senator Hefner moved to bracket the bill until January 15, 1988. The first motion pending then, Mr. President, is that motion to indefinitely postpone by Senator Hall. Senator Hall would like to withdraw that motion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: It is withdrawn.
