Senator Haberman asked me that question if this was included. Off the record and for the record, Senator Haberman, yes, those costs are included in the A bill before you. With that, I would urge the body's advancement of 868A.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Discussion on LB 868A. Anything further, Senator Hall?

SENATOR HALL: I just move the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Landis, did you...thank you. The question is the advancement of the A bill. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the advancement of LB 868A. Would members of the Transportation Committee under the north balcony...thank you. If you would care to be of help...thank you. Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 868A.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The A bill is advanced. Anything for the record, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Business and Labor whose Chair is Senator Hall would report LB 942 to General File with amendments; LB 1130 to General File with amendments. Those are signed by Senator Hall. (See pages 827-29 of the Legislative Journal.)

Senator Nelson would like to print amendments to LB 647 in the Journal. (See page 829 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have a Reference Report referring LB 1234 to the Revenue Committee, and notice of hearing, Mr. President, confirmation hearing from the Education Committee. That's signed by Senator Withem as Chair. That's all that I have.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Proceeding to General File, Mr. Clerk, the holdover bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 88 was a bill introduced by Senators Landis, Morehead and Marsh. (Read title.) The bill was pulled from committee, Mr. President, on March 31 of last year. That motion was offered by Senator Landis. On February 8 of this year, there was an amendment to the bill offered by Senators
