document, holds for an individual. And it says that the penalties ought to be just, but they also ought to be restrictive enough so that it is not an issue that is taken lightly. Ladies and gentlemen, I would urge the body's adoption of the Hall amendment to LB 88.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Hall amendment to LB 88. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Hall's amendment to the bill.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** The amendment is adopted. Anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?

**CLERK:** Mr. President, I do, thank you. New A bill, 966A, by Senator Scofield. (Read by title for the first time.) Revenue gives notice of hearing. Banking Committee reports 1220 to General File with committee amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Remmers. Transportation Committee would report 1007 to General File with amendments, 1128 to General File with amendments. Those are signed by Senator Lamb. Government Committee reports LR 261 to General File, LB 922 to General File, LB 977 General File, LB 1174 General File, LB 1143 to General File with amendments, LB 867 indefinitely postponed, LB 985 indefinitely postponed, LB 1080 and LB 1088 indefinitely postponed. Those are all signed by Senator Baack as Chair. The last item, Mr. President, Senator Wesely has amendments to be printed to LB 1100. (See pages 832-37 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I now have a motion to indefinitely postpone LB 88. That is offered by Senator McFarland. The introducers have the option to lay the bill over, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** Senator Landis, Senator Morehead, what are your wishes?

**SENATOR LANDIS:** This is a kill motion? Let's take it up. Let's take it up again.

**SPEAKER BARRETT:** Thank you. Senator McFarland, please.

**SENATOR MCFARLAND:** And again we shall, Senator Landis. Thank
