CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: I move to advance.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion? If not, all those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Ayes have it, the motion carries, the bill is advanced. Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Next bill is 551A. I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Just ask that the bill be advanced. I think it is going to cost about \$6,000.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Okay, thank you. Any discussion? Seeing none, those in favor of the advancement of the bill say aye. Opposed no. Carried, the bill is advanced. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Urban Affairs, whose Chair is Senator Hartnett, reports LB 931 to General File with amendments, signed by Senator Hartnett. Senator McFarland has amendments to LB 520 to be printed, and Senator Withem to LB 1155, and Senator Wesely to LB 377. I have a new resolution, LR 283, by Senator Coordsen and others. (Read summary of the resolution. See pages 863-68 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk has presented to the Governor the bill passed on Final Reading this morning. (Re: LB 428.) Enrollment and Review reports LB 864 to Select File with E & R amendments, LB 868 Select File, LB 868A to Select File with amendments, LB 88 to Select File with amendments.
