

February 18, 1988 LB 957, 975

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dierks would move to amend the bill. Senator Dierks' amendments are on page 803 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Dierks, please.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. President and members of the body, there are currently two or three county airports in Nebraska that remit all their cash income to the county treasurer, this is by law. The county treasurer must then in turn issue a check back to these county airports in the same amount. It's just simply a duplication of effort. This amendment simply eliminates that step. We've checked with the Nebraska Association of County Officials and they are in favor of this. I just urge that you approve this amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the Dierks amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Dierks' amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Dierks amendment is adopted. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Morehead, would you like to move the advancement of your bill.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Yes, Mr. President and colleagues, I'd like to ask for the advancement of LB 975.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. We're going to pass over number 858, I understand. We'll move on to LB 957.

CLERK: LB 957, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rod Johnson, would you move, please.
