PRESIDENT: LB 1117 advances. LB 1117A.

CLERK: LB 1117 was a bill introduced by Senator Withem. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Withem, please.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, Mr. President and members of the body, I believe my answer to Senator Langford's question answered the A bill question. This is a bill that will cost, and, as I indicated in my beginning, there will be a time when we may set our priorities on spending. I would argue with you that this is a major enough advancement that it should be included within those spending measures that we do consider favorably. At this point, I would ask you to advance this A bill, along with the bill, onto Select File and ultimately onto Final Reading. The amount of the A bill is...and the costs are spelled out for you on this handout sheet. The cost is \$625,000.

PRESIDENT: The question is the advancement of LB 1117A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of the A bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 1117A is advanced. Mr. Clerk, I believe you have some things to say.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. I've got...Senator Hall has amendments to be printed to LB 864 and Senator Labeledz to LB 88. (See page 921 of the Legislative Journal.)
