PRESIDENT: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 823.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Anything to put in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. The Natural Resources Committee would report LB 1061 to General File with amendments. That is signed by Senator Schmit. Urban Affairs will report LB 1058 to General File. That is offered by Senator Hartnett as Chair. Appropriations Committee reports LR 263 to General File with amendments and LB 764 to General File with amendments, signed by Senator Warner. Judiciary Committee reports LB 1030 to General File, LR 260CA to General File with amendments, LB 121 General File with amendments, LB 463, LB 876, and LB 990 General File with amendments, and LR 246 as indefinitely postponed. Those are all signed by Senator Chizek as Chair. (See pages 973-82 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, a new resolution by Senators Beyer, Higgins, Withem, and Goodrich. (Read brief explanation of LR 294. See pages 972-73 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over, Mr. President.

I have amendments from Senator Hannibal to LB 994. Senator Morehead, do you still want to do your Exec Session? Mr. President, General Affairs would like to have an Executive Session now underneath the south balcony, south balcony, General Affairs, south balcony immediately, Mr. President. That is all that I have.

PR IDENT: Move on to LB 972, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, 972 was a bill introduced by Senator Haberman and a number of the members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7 of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee, Mr. President. (See page 532 of the Legislative Journal.)
