CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 1105.

PRESIDENT: LB 1105 is advanced. Anything to put in at this time, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Thank you. I have amendments from Senator Lamb to be printed to LB 257. I have a new A bill, LB 1028A, by Senator Marsh. (Read by title for the first time.) Judiciary Committee reports LB 1126 to General File; LB 118, indefinitely postponed; LB 120, indefinitely postponed; LB 928, indefinitely postponed; LB 951 and LB 1048, indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Chizek as Chair. Transportation Committee reports LB 833 to General File with amendments. That is signed by Senator Lamb. Senator Schmit reports LB 1182 to General File with amendments; and LB 1217, General File with amendments. Those are signed by Senator Schmit. Communication from the Governor to the Clerk. (Read communication.) And a second, Mr. President. (Read second communication. See pages 1018-27 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, new resolution by Senator McFarland. (Read summary of LR 295. See pages 1027-28 of the Journal.) That will be laid over. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: May I introduce a guest, please, of Senator Rogers. Under the south balcony we have Mr. Jerry Bowden of Cairo, Nebraska. Would you please welcome Mr. Bowden to the Legislature. Thank you. We ready to move on to Select File?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 124 has been considered on Select File. On April 21 of last year the Enrollment and Review amendments were adopted.
