

February 29, 1988 LB 857, 872, 874, 893

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 857 pass? Those in favor vote yes, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 1068-69 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 857 passes. LB 872.

CLERK: (Read LB 872 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 872 become law? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 1069 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 872 passes. LB 874.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 874 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 874 pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 1070 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 874 passes. LB 893.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President. Senator Schmit would move to return 893 to Select File for a specific amendment, that being strike the enacting clause. (See page 1071 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, very briefly, on
