LB 288A, 517A, 726A, 757A

PRESIDENT: Yes, I think that would be simpler. Thank you. Any further discussion? If not, the question is the postponement of LB 726A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 726A is indefinitely postponed. LB 288A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 288A is a bill by Senator Vard Johnson. I do have a motion from Senator Barrett to indefinitely postpone that bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett, please.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Mr. President and members, I would move that LB 288A be indefinitely postponed. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the postponement of LB 288A. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. President, please.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 288A is indefinitely postponed. LB 757A.

CLERK: LB 757A is a bill by Senator Chambers. There is a motion to indefinitely postpone that bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett, please.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Mr. President and members, I move that LB 757A be indefinitely postponed. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is...it is your bill, Senator Chambers. Did you wish to speak on the indefinite postponement? Okay, all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.
