LB 977, 1174

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 977.

SENATOR LABEDZ: LB 977 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1174.

CLERK: LB 1174 by Senators Landis, Moore, Withem, and Lowell Johnson. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 20, referred to Government, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Landis, on the advancement of LB 1174.

SENATOR LANDIS: Two things in the bill. One, it repeals the little section that's unconstitutional, limiting lobbyists to making only \$25 contributions to political campaigns. Secondly, it allows meals, travel and lodging for officeholders out of their campaign funds for the performance of their duties in their office. It came out without amendment and with unanimous action by the committee. I move for its advancement.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Landis, there are no further lights. Senator Landis has moved for the advancement of LB 1174. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of LB 1174. Please vote. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Madam Chairman, it is late and it's only four minutes till five o'clock but it still requires, constitutionally, 25 votes for this bill to move on to Select File, and when pressed to the wall, when forced to the mat, I might have to ask for a call of the house and I think I will ask for a call of the house. But I will accept call in votes for those tardy members who will straggle in.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Senator Landis. All those in favor of a call of the house vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR LABEDZ: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, the house is under call. Take call in votes, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Lamb voting yes.
