SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Morehead, on the advancement of LB 1103.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Thank you, Madam Chairman and colleagues. LB 1103 would establish, within the Department of Education, a program for health services, student health services, a consultant, a coordinator, if you will, to work with our school nurses in all of the pro...their individual programs in the school districts. I would ask for its adoption and advancement.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Morehead has moved for the advancement of LB 1103. There are no further lights. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on LB 1103? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the advancement of 1103, Madam President.

SENATOR LABEDZ: LB 1103 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1103A.

CLERK: 1103A, by Senator Morehead. (Read title.)

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Thank you, Madam Chairman. This would appropriate the funds for the position which would be adopted in 1103A. This presumably would be a registered nurse educator within the Department of Education to serve as a coordinator with the nurses in the districts, individual districts who need those services. I ask for its adoption.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Morehead has moved for adoption of LB 1103A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 1103A.
