LB 664, 664A, 836

Senator Lamb. A machine vote has been requested on the advancement of 664. Those in favor of the advancement of the bill please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of 664, Mr. President.
