

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I'm considering that, yes.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 1 nay to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Did you say that call in votes were acceptable?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Yes, I did.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Please record your presence. Let's get rolling here. (Gavel.) Please take your seats and record your presence. Let's go. We have one more to handle after this one. Please hang in there a few minutes and we'll get it done. (Gavel.) We're voting on the committee amendments. Call in votes are acceptable.

CLERK: Senator Baack voting yes. Senator Rogers voting yes. Senator Wesely voting yes. Senator Smith voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Well, Mr. Clerk, I guess we're going to have to round some up. Who are we lacking?

CLERK: We're looking for Senators Chizek, Vard Johnson, Chizek.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Chizek, Senator Hefner, Senator Goodrich.

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting yes. Senator Nelson voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hannibal, do you want to talk about the
