LB 518, 518A, 1165

SENATOR MARSH: On the bill, not the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Any further discussion on it, Senator Vard? The question is the adoption of the Vard Johnson amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Vard Johnson amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, Senator Hefner would move to indefinitely postpone LB 518. Senator Johnson has the option of laying the bill over.

PRESIDENT: What do you say, Senator Vard Johnson?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Why don't we lay it over?

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I'll lay it over.

PRESIDENT: All right, thank you. Do you want to lay over LB 518A also?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: Yes. Move on to LB 1165.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1165 was a bill introduced by Senator Bernard-Stevens, Scofield, Morehead, Baack, Barrett, Lamb. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 20, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vard Johnson, are you going to take the committee amendments? Please.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I've got to get the bill out.

PRESIDENT: All right, we'll wait.
