The balance would be either cash or non-General Fund money, at least, and you will recall the civil action claims is the result of lawsuits in which the state has been involved, and they have a judgment or a cost associated with a judgment that must be paid, and I move that the rule be suspended and allow the introduction of this bill so that it can be printed over the recess.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Any further discussion? If not, the question is the rules be suspended to allow the introduction. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This requires 30 votes, please. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the bill introduction. Mr. President, new bill, LB 1237 introduced by the Appropriations Committee. (Read for the first time by title. See page 1178 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Warner would now move to suspend Rule 3, Sections 4 and 13, Rule 6, Section 1 to place the bill directly on General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I so move. This would be placing the bill on General File. Obviously, it already has been reviewed, as I indicated, by the various committees. I move its adoption.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the introduction of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This also requires 30. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to suspend the rules and place the bill directly on General File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended. It is placed on General File. Items for the record, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb has amendments to LB 1100 to be printed; Senator Labeledz has amendments to LB 1041 to be printed. (See pages 1178-80 of the Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, that is all that I have.
