

Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record their presence. Please look up to see if your light is on. Still looking for Senator Morehead. We have a request for a roll call vote in reverse order. Senator Hall, may we go ahead without Senator Morehead?

SENATOR HALL: Sure.

PRESIDENT: All right. (Gavel.) If you'll please take your seats so the Clerk can hear the response. We have...the question is the acceptance of the Hall amendment. Roll call vote in reverse order, Mr. Clerk.
