SPEAKER BARRETT PRESIDING

SPEAKER BARRETT: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber and to the forty-first working day in this, the Second Session of the 90th Legislature. Chaplain for the day, Reverend Saunda King of the Presbyterian Church of the Master in Omaha. Reverend King.

REVEREND KING: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, Reverend King. Hope you can come back again. Roll call.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Any reports, messages or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, several things. First item is one correction. (Read correction for the Journal as found on page 1286 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and engrossed LB 88 and find the same correctly engrossed; LB 165, LB 819, LB 863, LB 863A, LB 933, LB 948, LB 958, LB 970, LB 984, LB 1013, LB 1013A, LB 1033, LB 1034, LB 1054, LB 1077, LB 1078, LB 1093, LB 1114, LB 1136, LB 1146, LB 1157, LB 1169 and LB 1170, all those reported correctly engrossed.

I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Withem regarding LB 1225 and a second Opinion to Senator Wesely regarding LB 1097.

Mr. President, I have amendments to be printed to LB 1100 by Senator Lynch.

And, Mr. President, LR 263 and LR 308 are ready for your signature. (See pages 1286-94 of the Legislative Journal for all the above announcements.) That's all that I have.
