LB 657, 963

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lynch, who is Chair of the Rules Committee would move to suspend Rule 6, Section 7(b), so as to permit consideration of bills scheduled for Final Reading today.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, members, I do ask to move that the rules be suspended to Rule 6, Section 7(b), to permit consideration of LB 657, LB 823, LB 963, LB 963A, LB 980, LB 980A, LR 7CA for Final Reading today.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion? If not, those in favor of the motion please vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the rules suspension.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion is adopted. Members, please return to your seats for Final Reading. I would ask the cooperation of the Sergeants-at-Arms, please. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 657 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 657 become law? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 1297 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 657 passes. We'll pass over 823E and 934. LB 963E, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 963 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 963 with the emergency clause attached become law? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 1297-98 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 4 nays, 4 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
