SPEAKER BARRETT PRESIDING

SPEAKER BARRETT: Welcome to the final working day in this week's legislative session. To open the day our chaplain is the Reverend John Davis, the Beaver Crossing Methodist Church and the Seward Salem United Methodist Church. Pastor Davis. (Gavel.)
