SENATOR MARSH: It is a way to make, to utilize better the campus, the facilities that are there...

I didn't understand where this center was in terms of location and I hadn't heard of that before. That must be something fairly new out there, but it stays on campus in other words?

SENATOR MARSH: Yes.

SENATOR WESELY: It is just a different way to utilize staff and facilities? Okay. What is the \$192,380 that Senator Hannibal says he can answer dealing with the...the money comes out of the child welfare, subprogram K, and I'm just...what is that and...?

SENATOR MARSH: It is currently dollars that are in Title 20. We're just making a new subcommittee out of, new subunit out of that to provide more services for families for flexibility, for unifying services.

SENATOR WESELY: Is there some savings in this child welfare subprogram K or something that...

SENATOR MARSH: No. We wanted to set those number of dollars aside.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay. Senator Hannibal, do you have a better answer?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: No. If I may, Mr. Speaker, no, Senator Marsh is absolutely correct.
