SENATOR HALL: It hadn't shown up yet.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, that was the way the bill was introduced.

SENATOR WARNER: So I assume that the committee amendment does not create a problem there, or it addresses that issue so that it could be processed without penalty.

SENATOR BAACK: That's my understanding that the way we amended the committee amendments, the Department of Social Service no longer has that same problem that they felt they had and would have required that big of a fiscal note with it.

SENATOR WARNER: Okay.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any other questions or discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, those in favor of the adoption of the committee amendments please vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.
