

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Marsh, please.

SENATOR MARSH: Good morning, Mr. Speaker. I would move for the adoption of the resolution. It expresses our appreciation to elementary school Hill and Holmes. I will take no further time. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Discussion? If not, those in favor of the adoption of LR 321 please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of LR 321.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LR 321 is adopted. LR 322.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 322 is offered by the Speaker. It is found on page 1314. (Read summary of resolution.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: The Chair of the Exec Board, Senator Labedz, please.
