SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this particular section does not have a committee amendment. It increases the cash appropriation to the Game and Parks \$31,400 for '88-89. It is the replacement of equipment to solar panels and so forth that were destroyed by a fire that occurred in November of '87 at Branched Oak recreation area and it is the funding to replace that building that was consumed by fire, as was indicated. No committee amendment to the proposal.
