SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The motion is to adjourn until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock. It is not debatable. A machine vote has been requested. All in favor of adjourning please vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 2 ayes, 18 nays to adjourn, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion fails. To the Haberman amendment to the Ashford amendment, Senator Ashford, followed by Senator Wesely.

SENATOR ASHFORD: I call question on the Haberman amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Five hands I do see. Those in favor of closing debate please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate ceases. Senator Haberman, to close. No closing. The question is the adoption of the Haberman amendment to the Ashford amendment to LB 855. Those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Haberman's amendment to Senator Ashford's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The Haberman amendment is adopted. To the Ashford amendment as amended, Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: I will just close by urging that it be advanced or be voted for.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion on the Ashford motion to advance? Senator Chambers. Yeah, to adopt the amendment, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, we've adopted the amendment, I believe, haven't we?

SPEAKER BARRETT: We have adopted the Haberman amendment to the
