Now I understand that it does maybe only take a couple of hours a day, but it would seem to me it is very demanding and I would have a problem to put into statutory treatment of one nature for athletes which was not accorded to others although I do not raise that as an objection to the bill as far as my own vote because I have some problem with it in its entirety.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Warner. Yours was the last light on the committee amendments. We now proceed to Senator Baack to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and members, I think that, you know, it's been emphasized that one of the parts of the committee amendment I think is really important is this changing the operative date and making sure that at least four other of the Big Eight states have to enact laws similar and I think that what this does is this allows us to put something into statute and to make a very dramatic statement to the NCAA that we believe in this, that it is something that they ought to be looking at in when they write their new rules and regs, they ought to be looking at this issue. I also would like to recommend to everyone, even though we, the committee amendments strikes sections one through eight of the bill, I would certainly recommend to everyone to read those sections because there is a lot of really good material in there. As Senator Chambers said, it is creative material, but it is excellent substantive material as far as I am concerned that really does back up why he believe in this so strongly and I would encourage you to read those sections even though the committee amendments do strike them. So with that, I would just urge the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR LANDIS: The question is, shall the committee amendments be adopted. Those in favor will vote aye, those opposed vote no. Please return to your chairs so we may dispose of this question. The Clerk will record.
