SENATOR HALL: It looks like I'm going to need a call of the house, so I would ask for one now.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Motion has been made for a call of the house. We'll go to a vote. All in favor say aye, those opposed...Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Madam President.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: The house is under call. Will you please return to your seats and check in. We're looking for Senator Ashford. Senator Goodrich, will you please check in. Senator Haberman, will you please check in. Looking for Senator Hannibal and Senator Higgins. Senator Labeledz, will you please check in. Senator Peterson. House is under call. Senator Higgins and Senator Peterson, we need you. Senator Hall, do you want to go ahead and proceed? There's been a request for a roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1667 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 23 nays, Madam President.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: The motion is adopted. Raise the call. What do you have next, Mr. Clerk? Yes. The Clerk has some items to read into the record.

CLERK: Madam President, Senators Ashford and Conway have amendments to LB 1178 to be printed, Senator Warner to LB 684. (See pages 1668-71 of the Journal.)
